



Combined Test Schooling Show

For those unfamiliar with a combined show, it offers riders two phases of a horse trial – dressage and stadium. Scores of both phases are combined for a final score for each rider. Dressage only or stadium only rides are also available for schooling purposes. This format is an excellent schooling opportunity to prepare for a Horse Trial and is very popular in southern Ontario where it has extended to an actual series of show that include year end awards. This show is sanctioned by NBEA and as such we adhere to their rules and guidelines.

Date: Saturday, July 28th

Location: Harvey Station, NB. **Directions:** 30 minutes southwest of Fredericton off the Trans Canada Highway, take Harvey/St. Stephen/St. Andrews exit; stay straight on Rte 3. Pass through village of Harvey up steep hill; farm on right (#2044).

Judge: Nancy McAlinden

Format: Dressage tests will be run in the morning followed by a break and the setting of the stadium courses. You may register for dressage only, stadium only or both, but prizes are awarded for ONLY combined entries.

Divisions:

Entry – Dressage tests is Entry Test A; Stadium Maximum Height: 85cm

Pre-training – Dressage tests is Pre-training Test A; Stadium Maximum Height: 96cm

Training – Dressage tests is Training Test A; Stadium Maximum Height: 105cm

(Note: Training will ONLY run if there are at least 5 riders)

Cost: \$50 per horse/rider combination or \$25 for either dressage or stadium. **Late entries add \$10.**

Refunds: Before CD, less \$20 administration fee. After CD, with vet or doctor's certificate, less \$20 administration fee. All entries must include a photocopy of NBEA memberships. Cheques made payable to Lori Leach.

Stabling: Limited on-site stabling available \$25/stall. First come, first served. No refund on stall deposit which must be included with entry form.

** Remember to put corks in your horse's shoes and bring bug spray for yourself and your horse.
